Run pilots that implement OPR practices to generate evidence



Create incentives for and strengthen monitoring of innovative research dissemination



Increase awareness of and train researchers on alternative metrics



Exploit ongoing policy developments at EU and national levels and integrate OPR, innovative dissemination and alternatives metrics practices



Fund further research on the impact of Open Science practices for solving gender and diversity issues

 OpenUP is an H2020 project funded by the European Union (GA No 710722).

OpenUP Pilot 1 tested and demonstrated the practicability of open peer review at scientific conferences. Experiences and acceptance by researchers, reviewers and conference organisers involved were positive.

OpenUP survey showed that there are enthusiastic early adopters of innovative dissemination methods, but a wider uptake is hindered by the lack of skills and time among researchers.

A third of the OpenUP survey respondents were aware of the term altmetrics and only 15% of the total respondents used it in their work.

Country review conducted by OpenUP showed that current national and EU-level policy developments provide a window of opportunity to foster the uptake of novel Open Science practices.

There is limited evidence on impacts of OPR, innovative dissemination and alternative metrics on gender equality in research and academia and further research is needed.
